COMPOSITION:

Each syringe of Gastrozoles contains: Omeprazole Sodium......... 2.4 grs.

DESCRIPTION:

Omeprazole is a potent antagonist of the proton pump H+K + ATPase, which regulates the final passage whithin the secretion of gastric acid stimulated by some secretagogue. Gastrozole Eq is irreversibly bound to the proton pump of the gastric paretal cells, producing a fast and effective inhibition of gastric acid secretion which creates a prolonged action (over than 24 hours).

INDICATIONS:

The product is desinged for the treatment and prevention of the syndrome of gastric ulcer in horses and foals older than 4 weeks. Treatment of esophagitis, erosive gastritis, gastroduodenal ulcers, and gastritis caused by ulcerogenic drugs. Such as flunixin meglumine or phenylbutazone. Treatment is indicated for 4 weeks.

ADMINISTRATION AND USAGE RECOMMENDATIONS

Oral Intake. It is recommended that the product be administered after fasting. Calibrate the ring on the syringe to the dose to the desired dose. Make sure the animal's snout does not contain food. Make sure the treated animal ingests the product. In case rejection or loss of dose it is recommended to administer correct dose again.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

For treatment of gastric ulcers: Gastrozole must be applied in doses of 4 mg/kg weight once a day during 28 consecutive days. Every mark on the syringe is designed to treat 100 kg of animal weight.

For prevention and repeated treatment of ulcers: Continue treatment with Gastrozole for 28 additional days, using a dose of 2 mg/kilo once a day. In this case use only one mark on the syringe to treat 200 kg of animal weight.
