Meloxicam. 0,5% injectable.

meloxic 0.5 % is a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAIDs) inhibitor COX-2 preference, enzyme that induces the synthesis of prostaglandins and thromboxane responsible for pain, inflammation and fever; thus, exerting anti-inflammatory, analgesic, anti-exudative and antipyretic effects.

MELOXIC DOGS

- It is the drug of choice when the inflammatory component is predominant.
- Its security record outperforms previous NSAIDs.
- It can be used for the control of post-operative pain or in cases of chronic pain during the prescribed period of time.

MELOXIC CATS

- There is considerable potential for toxicity to NSAIDs in cats, however with an appropriate dose and at appropriate intervals, meloxicam can be used safely.
- It is widely used for acute pain in the perioperative period and after trauma.



COMPOSITION

Each mL **meloxic 0.5 %** contains:
Meloxicam 5 mg



DOSES

DOGS:

Single dose of 0.2 mg/kg (0.4 mL/10 kg).
Intravenous or subcutaneous injection.

CATS:

Single dose of 0.3 mg/kg (0.6 mL/10 kg).
Subcutaneous injection.

NOTE: As a continuation of the injectable treatment, apply **meloxic** oral suspension, from the second day, at doses of 0.1 mg / Kg. (1 drop / kg), every 24 hours, for 5 to 7 days, or at the discretion of the Vet.
